## ABOUT BOARD READINESS PROGRAMME

The SID Board Readiness Programme (SID BRP) is designed to prepare senior executives and professionals for board directorship positions.

The one-year programme takes attendees through a comprehensive development journey, which includes self-assessment, professional training, board simulation exercises, mentorship, professional networking and accreditation.

Delivered by SID and its pre-eminent knowledge partners from across the governance ecosystem, the holistic programme seeks to raise awareness of the risks and opportunities confronting board directors, and focuses on equipping the attendees with the essential knowledge and skills required of board directors.

Now in its second edition, the SID BRP will be conducted concurrently with the SID WIT BRP to allow for peer-learning across diverse backgrounds.

### PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES AND OUTCOMES

Attendees can expect to achieve the following:

- Acquire knowledge and skills for board directors to perform their role effectively.
- · Develop board director competencies through the application of knowledge gained.
- · Attain board readiness certification, leading to board apprenticeship opportunities.
- Achieve SID Accredited Director credential upon passing exam.

The programme is designed for C-suite executives, or those with equivalent senior leadership experience, and who are keen to serve on boards.



### **SELECTION PROCESS**

SID will review all applications. Shortlisted candidates will be selected for an interview in person or via virtual conference. Successful candidates will be invited to participate in the programme.



SID-SCS WIT BRP

- For the Board Readiness Programme 2nd intake, there will be two participants groups (1) SID-SCS WIT Track and (2) SID BRP track.
- Participants of both tracks will jointly attend the knowledge modules, board simulations, 2 x group mentorship sessions, and graduation.
- The SID-SCS WIT group will have 4 additional sessions that is exclusive only to WIT: 2 x fireside chat sessions, 2 group mentorship sessions.
